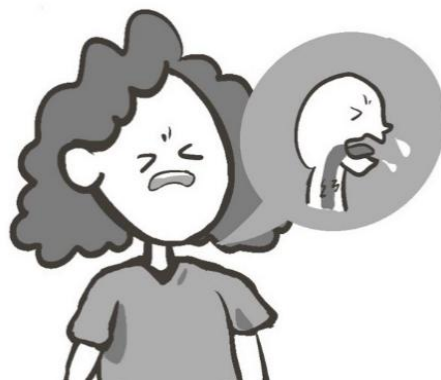

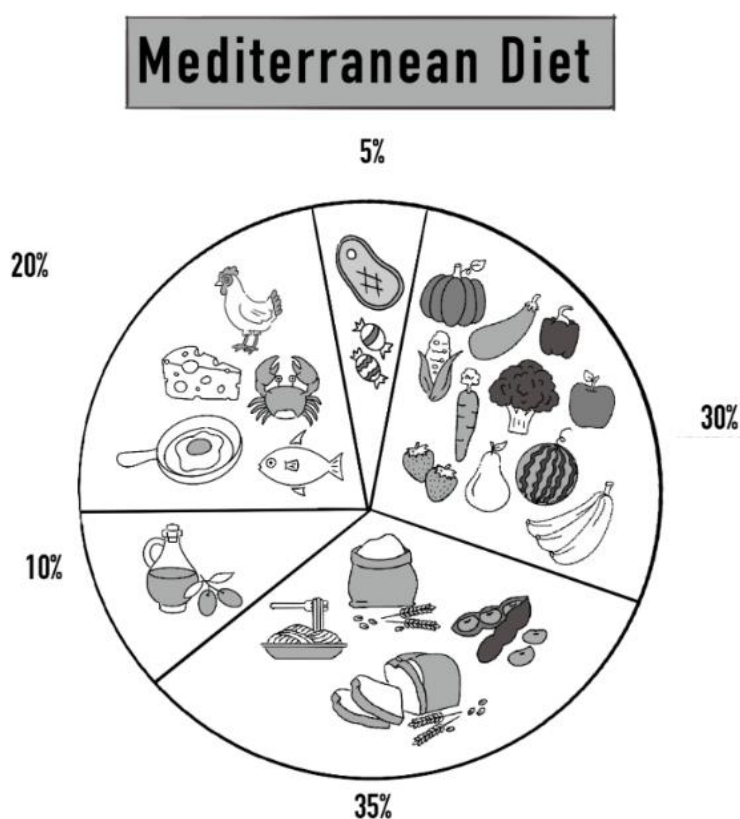

6. Eat less high-fat, high-sugar desserts.



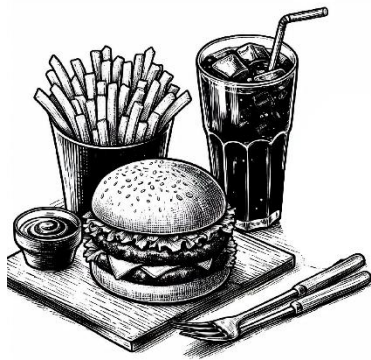

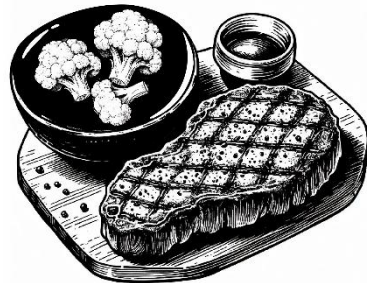
